Day 1 - Old Head of Kinsale GC

Arrive at Dublin / Shannon Airport and travel to Kinsale. Occupying a stunning and unique headland reaching out over two miles into the Atlantic Ocean, the Old Head of Kinsale is home to the most spectacular world-class golf course. Enjoy its breathtaking views and marvel at the sheer cliff-top drops into the Wild Atlantic Ocean. After golf enjoy a snack and beverage at the Terrace taking in the cuisine and views before departing for Kinsale.

Day 2 - Cork GC

Designed by Augusta's genius Alister MacKenzie and recently enhanced for the modern golfer – Cork Golf Club is sculpted from historic limestone quarries and unfolds magnificently along the banks of the City's Inner Harbour. A special place since 1888. Scenically situated in Cork Harbour, the Club has hosted many major amateur and professional Championships over the years including the Irish Open. Built on free-draining limestone, the course presents a crisp heath-like playing surface similar to links.

Day 3 - Castlemartyr GC

SET IN AN OLD MANOR ESTATE IN EAST CORK, THE CASTLEMARTYR GOLF RESORT IS AN 18 HOLE, 6,728 YD, PAR 72, INLAND LINKS STYLE COURSE. It is the creation of renowned golf course designer Ron Kirby, whose credentials were honed on such Irish masterpieces as the Old Head, and Mount Juliet, as well as Gleneagles in Scotland. In Castlemartyr Mr. Kirby has developed an inland links style course that creates a visually pleasing yet testing experience. The course is designed to be challenging and pleasurable for players of any calibre. Castlemartyr Golf Club provides first class service across all aspects of the golf spectrum, from the course, to the Club House and Pro Shop.

Day 4 - Mount Juliet GC

Day 5 - Druids Glen GC

The famed County Wicklow golf course, named European Golf Resort of the Year in 2005, was designed by Pat Ruddy & Tom Craddock and has undergone extensive upgrades to cement its nickname the 'Augusta of Europe'. Now a 7,222-yard par-72 course built to USGA standards. The resort, which was originally built in the 16th century as Woodstock House, has a rich history that includes hosting famous musicians and being the site of four Irish Opens - with Colin Montgomerie and Sergio Garcia among the winners. When you come to play at Druids Glen, you're playing one of the finest, most challenging, and most enjoyable golf courses in Europe - a course good enough to host the most prominent event in Irish golf.

Day 6 - K Club Palmer Course

The Arnold Palmer designed Ryder Cup Course is quite simply, one of Europe's most spectacular courses. It charms, it entices and invariably, brings out the very best in your game.
